Mid-Year Population

Web Release - September, 2024

Births, deaths and migration are the main factors that affect the population change of a country. As births, deaths and migrations are a continuous process, the population of a country or any territory is constantly changing over time. Therefore, every country conducts a population census to count the population at any specific moment of time. Accordingly, the last Census of Population and Housing in Sri Lanka was conducted in 2012 and the next census is planned to be conducted in the last few months of the year 2024.

During the inter-census period the mid-year population is estimated annually based on administrative data on births, deaths, and migration in the country and it is estimated as at July 01^{st} in every year. The mid-year population estimate for a respective year is calculated by adding the difference between registered births and deaths from July 1^{st} of the previous year to June 30^{th} of the respective year (Natural Increase) and net migration, to the mid-year population count of the previous year.

Mid-year population of the relevant year = Mid-year population of the previous year

+ Number of births - Number of deaths

+ Number of arrivals - Departures

Natural increase = number of births - number of deaths

Net migration = Number of arrivals to the country - Number of departures from the country

According to Table 1, during the time period from July 2012 to June 2013 there were 352,450 registered births and from July 2013 - June 2014 period, the number of registered births has been increased to 361,800. In the time periods of July 2014 to June 2015 and July 2016 to June 2017, registered births had reported a gradual decrease. The periods of July 2017 to June 2018 and from July 2018 to June 2019 had reported an increase in registered births compared to the previous year. However, again from the period July 2019 – June 2020 to the period July 2023 – June 2024, a gradual decrease has been reported in the number of registered births. The most nearby period from July 2023 to June 2024, the number of registered births has been reported as 228,091.

Further, there has been a gradual growth in the reported number of registered deaths from July 2012 to June 2024. But Compared to the time period July 2022 to June 2023, there has been a decrease in the number of registered deaths in the period from July 2023 to June 2024.

According to the data from the Department of Immigration and Emigration, during the periods from July 2015 to June 2018 and July 2020 to June 2021, arrivals were higher than

departures (positive net migration) and in the rest of the periods; departures were higher than arrivals (negative net migration).

The net migration from July 2022 to June 2023 was negative 222,715, and it was negative 176,932 from July 2023 to June 2024.

Thus, the mid-year population in the year 2024 has decreased by 120,555 compared to the previous year, because of the decrease in births and the increase in the departures from the country.
